



Shem: the peoples of the Middle and Far East Ham: the peoples of Africa and western Arabia Japheth: the peoples of Europe and the Near East








WHY GOD GAVE THE LAND OF ISRAEL TO THE JEWS


- The area is a land bridge that unites 3 continents and the developing civilizations. In the Old Testament, all western trade routes passed thru the land.

- Instead of death, the land bridge would provide life to civilization.











































TABERNACLE


Built in the days of Moses c. 1400 BC Moved with the Jews in the wilderness. Located in various towns in Israel. Used until 966 BC




THE ARK OF THE COVENANT

FLOOR PLAN








SOLOMON'S TEMPLE

First Temple 959 – 586 BC

Built by Solomon in 7 years 966-959 BC Destroyed by Nebuchadnezzar in 586 BC

BEGINNING OF ZERUBABBEL'S TEMPLE 516 BC -70 AD

Begun in 535 BC. Work stopped 534 – 519 BC. Finished in 516 BC Desecrated by Syrians in 168 – 165 BC. Rededicated in 165 BC
