







PREPARATION YEARS

DEVELOPED OUTLINE


- A. Nazareth to Bethlehem 68 miles Luke 2:1-20
 - 1. The angel Gabriel's announcement to Mary Luke 1:26-38
 - 2. An angel's announcement to Joseph Matt. 1:18-25
 - 3. Caesar's announcement of census c. 7 BC
 - 4. Joseph and Mary's trip to Bethlehem
 - 5. Jesus' birth and circumcision named Yeshúa in Aramaic One who saves
- B. Bethlehem to Jerusalem 6 miles Luke 2:22-38
 - 1. Joseph and Mary go to temple 40 days after Jesus' birth
 - 2. Simeon and Anna give praise to God for Jesus' birth
- C. Jerusalem to Bethlehem 6 miles Matt. 2:1-12
 - 1. Joseph and Mary return with Jesus and move into a house
 - 2. The Magi arrive in Jerusalem (Num. 24:17; Dan. 9:25-26)
 - 3. The Magi come to Bethlehem
 - 4. The Magi return home by another route
- D. Bethlehem to Egypt 100 miles Matt. 2:13-18
 - 1. An angel warns Joseph and Mary of danger
 - 2. They flee to Egypt
 - 3. Herod kills the babies in Bethlehem (approx. 20)
 - 4. Joseph, Mary and Jesus live in Egypt about one year
- E. Egypt to Nazareth 200 miles Matt. 2:19-23; Luke 2:39
 - 1. An angel tells Joseph that Herod is dead
 - 2. Joseph plans to stay in Bethlehem
 - 3. Joseph decides on Nazareth after a warning in a dream
- F. Nazareth to Jerusalem 62 miles Luke 2:40-50
 - 1. Jesus grows in wisdom and strength Isa. 50:4
 - 2. Jesus goes to the Temple in Jerusalem when 12 years old
- G. Jerusalem to Nazareth 62 miles Luke 2:51-52
 - 1. Jesus returns with His parents
 - 2. Jesus grows mentally, physically and spiritually
 - 3. Jesus works as a carpenter for 21 years Mark 6:3



1st YEAR of MINISTRY

DEVELOPED OUTLINE 1st year 28-29 AD (Tiberius became Caesar in 14 AD. Jesus begins in his 15th yr. Lk. 3:1)

- A. Nazareth to East Bethany c. 80 miles Mark 1:9; John 1:28
 - 1. announced by John the Baptist Matt. 3:1-12
 - 2. baptized by John (Both Jesus and John are in their early 30's about 33-34 yrs. old)
 - 3. empowered by the Spirit and validated by the Father Matt. 3:13-17
- B. East Bethany to the wilderness of Judea 18 miles Matt. 4:1-11
 - 1. tempted by Satan; cared for by angels
- C. Wilderness to East Bethany 18 miles
 - 1. announced by John as the Lamb of God John 1:29, 36
 - 2. investigated by 3 disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter, John the fisherman John 1:41-42
- **D.** East Bethany to Cana c. 87 miles
 - 1. calls Philip; proves Himself to Nathanael John 1:43-51
 - 2. performs His first miracle in Cana John 2:1-11
- E. Cana to Capernaum 16 miles John 2:12
- F. Capernaum to Jerusalem 85 miles
 - 1. celebrates the Passover
 - 2. clears out the Temple John 2:13-22
 - 3. works miracles John 2:23
 - 4. talks with Nicodemus John 3:1-21
- G. Jerusalem to East Bethany 18 miles John 3:22 4:2
 - 1. John and his disciples go further north along the Jordan
 - 2. Jesus and His disciples stay at E. Bethany for 8 months
 - 3. Sanhedrin members try to create jealousy
 - 4. John the Baptist is imprisoned
- H. East Bethany to Sychar 31 miles John 4:3-42
 - 1. leads the Samaritan woman and the townspeople to belief in Him
- I. Sychar to Cana 38 miles John 4:43-54
 - 1. heals an official's son
- **J. Cana to Nazareth** 7 miles Luke 4:16-30
 - 1. teaches in the synagogue
 - 2. is rejected by the people



2nd YEAR of MINISTRY

DEVELOPED OUTLINE 2nd year 29 or 30 AD - Jesus is now 35-36 years old.

- A. Nazareth to Capernaum c. 23 miles
 - 1. Makes His residence in Capernaum Matt. 4:13
 - 2. Calls 4 disciples to work with Him Peter, Andrew, John and his brother, James Matt. 4:18-22; Luke 5:1-11
 - ...had stayed with Jesus while in Judea and Samaria during 1st year (10 months)
 - ...had believed in Jesus and learned from Him (like a year of mentorship)
 - ...had gone back to their fishing business when they returned to Galilee
 - 3. Teaches in the synagogue; heals a man with an evil spirit Luke 4:31-37
 - 4. Goes to Peter's house; heals his mother-in-law Luke 4:38-39
 - 5. Heals many who are sick Luke 4:40-41

B. Capernaum to all Galilee 1 trip Mark 1:35-45

January to March

Takes the 4 disciples; teaches; heals a leper (Messianic miracle)

C. Returns to Capernaum Mark 2:1-14

Heals a paralyzed man; calls Matthew

D. Capernaum to Jerusalem 85 miles

April

- 1. Heals a lame man; defends His authority John 5:1-47
- 2. Disciples eat grain on the Sabbath Luke 6:1-5
- E. Jerusalem to Capernaum 85 miles
 - 1. Heals man with deformed hand Luke 6:6-11
 - 2. Teaches and heals by the Sea of Galilee Mark 3:7-12
- F. Capernaum to mountain 9 miles SW of Capernaum

May - June

Chooses 12 apostles; gives Sermon on the Mount Matt. 5 - 7; Luke 6:20-49

G. Mountain to Capernaum 9 miles

Heals servant of Roman captain Luke 7:1-10

H. Capernaum to all Galilee 2nd trip

June to August

- 1. Raises widow's son in town of Nain Luke 7:11-17
- 2. Answers questions from John the Baptist Luke 7:18-35
- 3. Rebukes the unrepentant cities Matt. 11:20-30
- 4. Eats with Simon the Pharisee Luke 7:36-50
- 5. Visits all the towns and villages Luke 8:1-3
- I. Returns to Capernaum

September to November


- 1. In Peter's house, Matt. 12:22-50
 - casts out an evil spirit (Messianic miracle)

teaches and is formally rejected by the Sanhedrin (unpardonable sin)

- 2. By the lake teaches parables Matt. 13:1-35
- 3. In Peter's house, alone with disciples explains parables Matt. 13:36-50
- J. Capernaum to Gerasenes 10 miles Mark 4:35 5:20

Calms the storm; heals the demon possessed man (Legion)

- K. Gerasenes to Capernaum 10 miles
 - 1. Raises Jairus' daughter and heals a sick woman Luke 8:41-56
 - 2. Heals 2 blind men Matt. 9:27-34
 - 3. Heals a man unable to speak because of an evil spirit (Messianic miracle) Matt. 9:27-34



3rd YEAR of MINISTRY

DEVELOPED OUTLINE 3rd year 30 or 31 AD - Jesus is now 36-37 years old.

- A. Capernaum to Nazareth for the last time c. 23 miles Mk. 6:1-6
 - 1. Teaches in the synagogue and heals a few of the sick but is still rejected.
- B. Nazareth thruout Galilee to Capernaum (3rd Trip) Mark 6:7-31

Winter

- 1. Sends the apostles 2 by 2 to encourage the believing remnant; follows them and preaches. Matt. 11:1
- 2. Joins them in Capernaum. Mk. 6:30
- 3. Hears about the death of John the Baptist.
- C. Capernaum to E. Bethsaida via Sea of Galilee 4 miles Mark 6:32-44

April

- 1. Goes by boat to E. Bethsaida to be alone with the apostles. Lk. 9:10
- 2. Teaches and heals the people who follow Him by land.
- 3. Feeds the 5 thousand. Matt. 14:15-21; Mk. 6:35-44; Lk. 9:12-17; Jn. 6:4-13
- D. East Bethsaida to Gennesaret via Sea of Galilee 6 miles Mk 6:45
 - 1. Disciples leave by boat for West Bethsaida crowds sent away.
 - 2. Jesus prays on the mountain while His disciples experience the storm.
 - 3. Jesus appears walking on the water; Peter walks on the water. Matt. 14:28-32
 - 4. They arrive at the plain of Gennesaret. (south of Capernaum)
- E. Gennesaret to Capernaum 5 miles
 - 1. Passes thru towns, healing those who believe. Mk. 6:53-56
 - 2. Teaches in the synagogues. John 6:22-71

Refuses a political kingdom; proclaims a spiritual one. John 6:15 Loses popularity and many of His followers; the 12 remain with Him.

- 3. Teaches about traditions of hand washing. Mk. 7:1-23
- F. Capernaum to Tyre/Sidon Matt. 15:21-28; Mk. 7:24-30

May - June


- 1. Travels 40 miles to the northwest to teach the apostles; heals the daughter of a Gentile woman.
- **G. Sidon to region of Decapolis** 60-80 miles Matt. 15:29-38; Mk. 7:31 8:9
 - 1. Heals all who believe; feeds the 4000.
- H. Decapolis to Magadan/Dalmanutha via Sea of Galilee Matt. 15:39; Mk. 8:9-12
 - 1. Pharisees demand a sign but Jesus refuses and leaves by boat.
- I. Magadan to E. Bethsaida via Sea of Galilee 8 miles Mk. 8:9-12
 - 1. Warns the apostles about the false teaching of the Pharisees; heals a blind man outside the village.
- J. E. Bethsaida to Caesarea Philippi 27 miles Matt. 16:13 17:13; Mk. 8:27 9:13; Lk. 9:28-36
 - 1. Tests the faith and understanding of the apostles.
 - 2. Tells them of His coming death and resurrection.
 - 3. Is transfigured before 3 apostles.
- K. Caesarea Philippi to Capernaum 27 miles Matt. 17:14 18:35
 - 1. Heals a boy with evil spirit.
 - 2. Pays the temple tax.
 - 3. Teaches about humility and forgiveness.
- L. Capernaum to Jerusalem 100⁺ miles John 7:2 10:21
 - 1. Goes thru Samaria and is rejected. Luke 9:51-56
 - 2. Attends the Feast of Tabernacles.

October

- 3. Deals with the woman taken in adultery.
- 4. Teaches in the women's court in Temple.
- 5. Heals a man **born** blind. (Messianic miracle)
- 6. Teaches that He is the Good Shepherd.
- M. Jerusalem thruout all Judea Luke 10:1 13:21
 - 1. Sends out 70 to teach and heal.
 - 2. Visits Mary and Martha in Bethany. 2 1/2 miles
 - 3. Teaches the story of the Good Samaritan and the apostles about prayer.
 - 4. Eats in home of a Pharisee and denounces their hypocrisy.
 - 5. Teaches the multitudes and heals a sick woman.
- N. Jerusalem John 10:22-39
 - 1. Attends the Feast of Dedication Hanukkah.

December


2. Teaches about His Deity - He is the Messiah, Christ; is almost stoned to death.



LAST 3 MONTHS of MINISTRY

DEVELOPED OUTLINE 4th year 31 AD - Jesus is now 37 years old.

- A. Jerusalem to East Bethany 18 miles; then thruout Perea Jn 10:40-42; Lk. 13:22 17:10
 - 1. Teaches in the villages of Perea
 - 2. Eats in the home of a Sanhedrin member
 - 3. Heals a man; teaches in parables
- B. East Bethany to West Bethany 15 miles John 11:1-54
 - 1. Jesus raises Lazarus; Caiaphas the high priest commands the death of Jesus
- C. West Bethany to Ephraim John 11:54
 - 1. An unknown area of Judea province; Jesus spends time alone with the apostles
- **D. Ephraim, Samaria, Galilee to West Bethany** Matt. 19:1 20:34; Lk. 17:11 19:28
 - 1. Heals 10 lepers
 - 2. Teaches thru illustrations, parables and answers to questions
 - 3. Answers the rich young Sanhedrin member
 - 4. Heals 2 blind men between the 2 towns of Jericho
 - 5. Eats and teaches in the home of Zacchaeus
 - 6. Returns to W. Bethany 6 weeks after raising Lazarus



Mt. of Olives to Temple to Mt. of Olives 1 mile Matt. 21:23 - 25:46 Tuesday 1. Returns to Jerusalem; examined by Sanhedrin in the Temple courtyard 2. Jesus examines the Sanhedrin 3. Leaves in late afternoon; stops with apostles on Mt. of Olives to answer their questions He tells them about future events: signs, preparation and judgment D. Mt. of Olives to West Bethany 2 miles Wed. to Thur. aft. 1. They eat in Simon's home where Mary anoints Jesus John 12:1-11 2. Judas arranges the betrayal Matt. 26:1-16 3. Jesus sends 2 apostles to prepare Passover Matt. 26:17-19 **E. W. Bethany to Jerusalem** 2½ miles Lk. 22:14-30; Jn. 13 - 14 **Upper Room Friday** 1. Deals with their lack of humility by washing the apostles' feet after sundown on Thursday 2. Declares His betrayal and denial; Judas leaves 3. Eats the Passover meal; uses the last part to establish a new meal for His followers The Lord's Supper, Holy Communion F. Upper Room to Gethsemane 3/4 mile Lk. 22:36-56; John 15:1 - 18:12 1. Instructs and prays for the apostles 2. Prays with apostles in garden; is betrayed by Judas G. Gethsemane to palace of Annas 3/4 mile John 18:12-14, 19-24 H. Annas to palace of Caiaphas next door Matt. 26:57 - 27:10 1. The Sanhedrin accuse Jesus of blasphemy; condemns Him to death 2. Peter denies Jesus 3. Judas returns the money; commits suicide I. Caiaphas to Pilate's palace 3/4 mile John. 18:28-38 6:00 am Friday Pilate finds Him innocent; sends Him to Herod J. Pilate to Herod ½ mile Luke 23:6-12 Asks Jesus questions; ridicules Him; returns Him to Pilate K. Herod to Pilate ½ mile Luke 23:13-25 1. Offers to punish Him; to release Him or Barabbas 2. Lets the soldiers whip Him 3. Washes his hands of the matter; turns Jesus over to the Sanhedrin, giving permission for His death L. Pilate to Calvary 1/4 mile Luke 23:26-49 9:00 am - 3:00 pm Friday 1. Needs Simon to carry His cross 2. Is placed on cross between 2 criminals 3. Is ridiculed; suffers the wrath of man from 9:00 am to noon 4. Suffers the wrath of God the Father from noon to 3:00 pm; His spiritual death 5. Speaks the "7 last words" during the 6 hours; His physical death 6. Signs accompany His death Matt. 27:51-54 M. Calvary to Joseph's tomb about 1-2 blocks distance

1. Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus (Sanhedrin) bury Him before sundown Fri. John 19:38-42

2. The Sanhedrin ask the Romans to seal the tomb; post a guard Matt. 27:62-66



LAST 40 DAYS

DEVELOPED OUTLINE Last 40 Days

Jewish Time

A. In Jerusalem

1. An earthquake; Jesus rises from the dead; an angel moves the stone.

Sunday morning

- 2. The 15 Roman soldiers leave to tell the Sanhedrin. Matt. 28:11-15
- 3. Mary Magdalene arrives at tomb, sees nothing, leaves to tell Peter and John. Jn. 20:1-2
- 4. Two other women come, see 1 angel, then 2; receive message for disciples and Peter Matt. 28:5-8, Luke 24:1-8
 Salome and Mary, wife of Clopas, (sister-in-law and sister of Mary, mother of Jesus) John 19:25
- 5. Peter and John come to tomb; John believes, Peter wonders; they go their separate ways. Luke 24:1-8
- 6. Jesus appears to:
 - Mary Magdalene when she returns to the tomb Jn. 20:11-18
 - Salome and Mary, wife of Clopas and mother of James, on the way to the apostles Matt. 28:8-10
 - Peter (probably in Garden of Gethsemane) Luke 24:34; 1 Cor. 15:5

B. On the Emmaus Road 7 miles Luke 24:13-34

Sunday afternoon

1. Jesus appears to 2 followers.

C. In Jerusalem, Jesus appears to:

- 1. The 10 apostles on the beginning of Monday, right after sundown Lk. 24:36-43 **Monday**
- 2. The 11 apostles the beginning of the next Monday, right after sundown Jn. 20:26-31 One week later

D. In Galilee, near Capernaum, Jesus appears to:

- 1. 7 apostles by the Sea of Galilee Jn. 21:1-24
- 2. The 11 apostles daily so He can teach them Lk. 24:44-49; Acts 1:3-6
- 3. Apostles on a Galilean hillside; 500 disciples 1 Cor. 15:6; Matt. 28:16
- 4. James, one of His blood relatives 1 Cor. 15:7

E. On the Mt. of Olives near Bethany Acts 1:6-12

Forty days later

1. Jesus gives final instruction to the 11 apostles and then ascends into heaven.
